



Pachypoessa lacertosa Simon, 1902

P. lacertosa, sp. nov. — ♂ long. 8-9 mill. — Cephalothorax niger, parte thoracica in medio late dilutiore et lineolis nigris obliquis et biseriatis, antice convergentibus notata, (fere omnino depilis) saltem utrinque rubro-pubescent. Pili oculorum supra oculos et extus rubri, subtus albi. Clypeus sat angustus, setis albis paucis longissimis et biseriatis, marginalibus decumbentibus, ornatus. Abdomen longum, supra fuscum, luteo-pubescent et lineolis quatuor rubro-pilosus ornatum, subtus atrum et parce cinereo-pilosum. Chelae sublaeves, vix striatae, nigrae, apice dilutiiores et rufulæ. Partes oris sternumque fusco-castanea. Pedes quatuor antici nigricantes, coxis castaneis, tarsis luteis, patellis tibiis metatarsisque subtus crebre et longe nigro-fimbriatis. Pedes quatuor postici castanei, coxis metatarsisque dilutioribus, tarsis luteis. Pedes-maxillares fusi, nigro-setosi; patella tereti, paulo longiore quam latiore; tibia breviore et paulo latiore, extus ad marginem apicalem, apophysi brevi, robusta et dentiformi armata; tarso sat longe ovato, teretiusculo; bulbo ad basin crassissimo, convexo et oblique truncato, ad apicem profunde fisso, ramulo interiore depresso et obtuso, exteriore fere parallelo sed apice abrupte acuto.
