

Phaulostylus (¹) **furcifer**, sp. nov. — ♂ long. 7-9 mill. — Cephalothorax obscure rubro-castanens, aurantiaco-pubescentis, utrinque, prope oculos, niger, glaber et nitidus, vitta submarginali lata, in parte thoracica linea media exili sed antice, inter oculos, ampliata, albo-pilosis, decoratus. Pili oculorum aurantiaci. Clypeus angustus parce et longe albo-pilosus. Abdomen longe oblongum, testaceum, supra albo-pubescentis et vittis latis binis, antice evanescientibus rubro-pilosus, ornatum. Chelae longissimae et porrectae, supra planae, obtusissime bicostatae, nigro-aeneae, intus setis spiniformibus erectis brevibus crebre vestitae, margine inferiore sulci, in parte apicali, leviter emarginato et dentibus parvis aequis, transversim ordinatis, armato, margine superiore dente maximo inaequaliter bifido, ramulo anteriore acuto et recto, altero, saltem duplo longiore, postice curvato et apice minute furcato, ungue longissimo, leviter ovato et compresso. Partes oris, sternum, pedesque quatuor anteriores, fuscocastanea, patellis anticis longis, tibiis metatarsisque aculeis inferioribus lateralibusisque armatis. Pedes quatuor postie obscure fulvi, femoribus infuscatis. Pedes-maxillares rubro-castanei, sat graciles et longi; tibia patella saltem aequilonga, paulo graciliore, tereti, extus ad apicem apophysa nigra, brevi et obtusissima munita; tarso anguste ovato; bulbo ovato, ad basin anguste producto et curvato, ad apicem stylo libero obliquo munito.

Madagascar : sinus « Antongil » dictus (*Macquerys*).

(1) **Phaulostylus**, nov. gen. — A *Colytto* (Thorell) differt tibiis cunctis aeneo-dorsali carentibus, laminis maris sat angustis extus obtusis. — Typus : *P. furcifer* E. Simon.
