MENOPSILA

Menopsila D. Bennett, Perrichot, and Engel, 2014:42. Type species: *Menopsila dupeae* D. Bennet, Perrichot, and Engel, 2014, by original designation and monotypy.

Comment by A.V. Antropov of 29 Dec 2014 (translated from Russian by W.J. Pulawski): “this genus certainly should be assigned to the subtribe Spilomenina, as indicated by the forewing venation (in particular, a not elongate first submarginal cell and an enlarged pterostigma), the absence of a hypersternaulus, and particularly a sessile gaster, without a petiole consisting of sternum I only”.
