## **NOTOTIS**

*Nototis* Arnold, 1927:64 (as subgenus of *Belomicrus*). Type species: *Belomicrus bicornutus* Arnold, 1927, by monotypy.

Name derivation: from the Latin noun *notum* (dorsum) and Greek οτος (ear), with reference to the shape of the metanotal squamae,

Revision: Antropov, 2007b:261.

### **1. *bicornutus* (Arnold)**
