ODONTOSPHEX

Odontosphex Arnold, 1951:154. Type species: *Odontosphex bidens* Arnold, 1951, by original designation and monotypy.

1. *bidens* Arnold

2. *damara* Pulawski

Odontosphex damara Pulawski, 1991a:953, ♀, ♂. Holotype: ♂, Namibia: Damaraland: 38 km west of Khorixas (CAS). – S. Gess and F. Gess, 2003:128 (Namibia: visiting flowers of *Chamaesyce glanduligera* (Pax) Koutnik, Euphorbiaceae), 2006:20 (Namibia, visiting flowers of *Chamaesyce glanduligera*, Euphorbiaceae).

3. *fritzi* Menke

Odontosphex fritzi Menke, 1967d:145, ♀, ♂. Holotype: ♂, Argentina: Rio Negro: Lamarque (originally M. Fritz coll., now MACN). – R. Bohart and Menke, 1976:573 (in checklist of world Sphecidae); Fritz, 1993:17 (holotype in M. Fritz coll.); Amarante, 2002:63 (in catalog of Neotropical Crabronidae).

4. *leleji* Mokrousov and Proshchalykin

Odontosphex leleji Mokrousov and Proshchalykin, 2021c:140, ♂. Holotype: ♂, Turkmenistan: Badkhyz Nature Reserve: Yeroyulanduz valley at 35.70°N 61.97°E (ZIN). – Schmid-Egger and van Harten, 2022:565 (United Arab Emirates: Abu Dhabi, Al Wathba; comparison with *Odontosphex bidens*).

5. *paradoxus* Menke

Odontosphex paradoxus Menke, 1967d:145, ♂, ♀. Holotype: ♂, Argentina: La Rioja: Mascasin (UCD). – R. Bohart and Menke, 1976:573 (in checklist of world Sphecidae; Bolivia: Cordillera Province); Radović, 1985:66 (sting apparatus analyzed); Amarante, 2002:63 (in catalog of Neotropical Crabronidae); Dollfuss, 2017b:1272 (locality records from Argentina).

6. *willinki* Menke
