From the Greek περισσόν, strange, remarkable form. Gender: neuter.

Perisson Pate, 1938c:156. Type species: *Nysson basirufus* Brèthes, 1913, by original designation and monotypy.

1. *basirufum* (Brèthes)

Nysson basirufus Brèthes, 1913:135, ♀, ♂ (as *basirufum*, incorrect original termination).
