## **XENOSPHEX**

*Xenosphex* F. Williams, 1954a:97. Type species: *Xenosphex xerophilus* F. Williams, 1954, by original designation and monotypy.

Revision: F. Parker, 1966b.

### **1. *boharti* F. Parker**

### **2. *timberlakei* F. Williams**
