Phoroncidia aurata O. P.-Cambridge, 1877

5. PHORONCIDIA AURATA. (Plate LVH. figs. 4, 4 a.)

Phoroncidia aurata, Cambridge, Ann. & Mag. Nat. Hist. ser. 4, vol. xix. p. 31, pl. vii. fig. 9 (1877).

Four examples of this rare and extremely beautiful species were obtained in the Betsileo country by Mr. Cowan. Two of these are typical, the abdomen being of a fiery golden colour, with black spines upon red bases; the two others are considerably larger, and the abdomen is of a metallic silver colour, the spines black with redbrown bases, and the occilations black. This form I propose to indicate as var. argentuta (fig. 4 b).
